

Rural Industries Skill Training Centre Incorporated (4198) 2019 RTO Performance Summary Report

This report details the **2019** results of the *Student Satisfaction Survey* and from the *Employer Satisfaction Survey*, as well as results from previous years of the surveys (where available). The below overview presents the key Performance Measures across **Student experience**, **Student outcomes**, and **Employer feedback**.

In 2019, 70 students from Rural Industries Skill Training Centre Incorporated (4198) took part in the survey. This is a response rate of 36.3%. The average response rate for all of Victoria was 35.7%.

In 2019, 50 of the respondents in the survey were completers and 20 were early leavers.

Students had an "improved employment status after training" if they were employed before training and afterwards had greater responsibility, a promotion, started a new role, earned more, worked more hours, gained extra skills, completed an apprenticeship/traineeship or set up a business. For those that were unemployed, they had "improved employment status" if they got a job or set up a business.






Proportion of VET students who were satisfied with training provided by Rural Industries Skill Training Centre Incorporated


Proportion of VET students who reported a positive perception of the assessment process


Proportion of VET students who were satisfied with generic skills and learning experiences




Improved employment status after training by completion status





